**RESOLVED** to invite the architect and SCP to a meeting to clarify the JPF car park and building projects.

**PROPOSED** Cllr Dunn**SECONDED** Cllr Hall.On being put to the vote, the Resolution carried unanimously.

#### 11/25L PLAY AREA ON ST MARY'S ESTATE.

**RESOLVED** not to install a fence around the play area, once the Council takes on management from the Borough Council.

**RESOLVED** to install dog fouling and dogs on leads signs.

**RESOLVED** to approach the Borough Council to request that they install a temporary fence and hedge along the St Marys Road border.

**PROPOSED** Cllr Dunn**SECONDED** Cllr Walters.On being put to the vote, the resolution carried unanimously.

#### 12/25L NETWORK RAIL TO USE PART OF THE JPF CARPARK.

**RESOLVED** to agree in principle to the request providing the works take place outside the school holiday period.

**RESOLVED** to request Network Rail install the depth gauges on Meadow Lane and Mill Lane railway bridges in lieu of a payment.

**PROPOSED** Cllr Walters**SECONDED** Cllr Bloor.On being put to the vote, the Resolution carried unanimously.
