To register please complete and return your entry form, along with the appropriate entry donation, to Colwich Parish Council, Parish Centre, St Marys Road, Little Haywood ST18 0TX by Monday 17th July 2023.

The non-refundable entry donation will be £5.00 per household.

Streets should make an appropriate donation based on the number of households taking part.

All entry monies will be donated to the Council's charities of the year: Little Laura and Blood bikes.

Judging will take place by public vote during the weekends of 22nd/23rd and 29th/30th July 2023. All votes to be received by the Parish Council by no later than 11th August 2023.

Entry details, including addresses for scarecrows and a voting form, will be made available via the Parish Website, Social Media pages and Noticeboards before Friday 21st July 2023. Photographs of scarecrows will be added before Friday 28th July 2023.

Winners, with presentation of trophies, will be announced at the Parish Council meeting to be held on Thursday 7th September 2023. Details of the winners will be published via the Parish Website, Social Media pages, Noticeboards and within a future Newsletter.

Entrants are reminded that it is their responsibility to comply with any and all safety matters and regulations. The Council accepts no liability.

All entries must be visible from the Highway. Residents **MUST NOT** enter the curtilage of properties.
