10/14P <u>15/22756/REM</u> AT LAND OFF LITTLE TIXALL LANE, GREAT HAYWOOD

RESOLVED that the Assistant Clerk should write to Stafford Borough Council expressing the Council's concerns about:

- The proposed parking provision;
- That all the Affordable Housing has been placed at the rear corner of the site next to the A51 rather than being spread across the development;
- The proposal includes the building of multiple 4 and 5 bedroom properties, which were not shown on the original outline application and are not in keeping with the local Streetscene, whereas the Council would prefer more 1 & 2 bedroom dwellings to allow local residents to downsize, thus family properties elsewhere in the parish;
- There does not appear to be adequate SUDS provision even though the site is known to flood from surface run off.

In mitigation the Council would request a s.106 contribution towards:

- Allotment provision locally;
- Children's play equipment; and
- A new burial ground.

11/14P <u>15/22731/OUT</u> AT LAND ADJACENT TO SHENLEY COTTAGE AND THE BUTTS, MAIN ROAD, LITTLE HAYWOOD

RESOLVED that the Assistant Clerk should write to Stafford Borough Council objecting to the application for the following reasons:

- The site is outside the Settlement Boundary in the proposed Neighbourhood Plan.
- The applicant has not demonstrated a need for the additional dwellings.
- The Borough can demonstrate a 5 year housing supply.
- The Borough has already reached the target for the KSVs in the Plan for Stafford.
- The development will result in more journeys than claimed in the application.
- The development will have an adverse effect on the local green infrastructure and the conservation area.

In mitigation the Council would request a s.106 contribution towards:

- Allotment provision locally;
- Children's play equipment and new surfaces at the JPF
- A new burial ground; and
- That the applicant agrees to designate Local Green Spaces on the other land in their ownership in line with the proposed Neighbourhood Plan

[Note; the Clerk has subsequently written an additional objection letter to the Borough Planning Department covering the Neighbourhood Plan submission].
