Cllr Dunn continued the briefing, detailing the meeting with Staffordshire FA on Monday 1st June 2026. Cllr Dunn noted that he is awaiting an introduction from Staffs FA to the Grounds Maintenance Association to obtain a full specification of the works required to the field. Once received, this will be used to obtain two quotes to access FA funds to improve the field, on-going maintenance programme and new grounds equipment.
